



Avocations - Mountain Climbing

Information regarding specific mountain climbing activities is obtained through an Avocation questionnaire (form ORD 9098A). It must be submitted with the application if the avocation (*hazardous sports*) question is answered "Yes". Whether an offer is made with or without the extra premium depends on the details provided by 9098A along with other information included in the application and inspection report. This questionnaire is made a part of the policy/contract once issued.

Experience, training, difficulty and grade of the climb, physical conditioning of the climber, club affiliation and climbing location are considered by the underwriter. This sport generally involves four activities: walking (*trail hiking or trekking*), rock climbing, snow or ice climbing and navigation. In most cases, standard to Occupation Class 3 will apply unless climbing is frequent, extends to higher peaks or is preformed outside the United States. (*Hiking or trekking would qualify for standard rates*).

Participation in multiple hazardous sports requires special consideration. Individuals showing evidence of carelessness or attempting to set records may be uninsurable.

Please refer to the following schedule for general guidelines for mountain climbing.*

Trail Hiking	S	Yes
North America - Rock and Mountain Climbing	1	No
Elsewhere - Rock and Mountain Climbing	3 up	No

If the mountain climbing warrants a "rating", there are 8 avocational rating classes. They are expressed as a permanent flat extra charge per \$1000 of insurance.
